

## BOWLING ESTABLISHMENT CONTRACT

This agreement entered into this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_ 20\_\_ by and between the St. Joseph USBC Association, hereinafter, known as the party of the first part, and /or operators of the \_\_\_\_\_ hereinafter known as the party of the second part, for holding the \_\_\_\_\_ events of the \_\_\_\_\_ annual \_\_\_\_\_ Tournament, under the management of the St. Joseph USBC Association, consists of the following terms and conditions, which the parties here to do, by their signatures, accept and agree.

**Dates:** The parties agree that the tournament will open on \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_ 20\_\_ and run on each weekend for dates agreed upon by both parties until all entrants have bowled. If entries warrant an extension, additional squads or weekends will be decided by mutual agreement. If entries warrant squads or weekends be deleted because of not enough participation of entries, or for any reason St. Joseph USBC Association deems necessary to delete squads or weekends there will be no extra charge to the party of the first part. A weekend shall start at \_\_\_\_\_ time on Saturday and continue through \_\_\_\_\_ time on Sunday. See last page for squad times.

**Foul Lights:** The party of the second part agrees to furnish USBC foul detecting devices and agrees to maintain them in good working order at all times.

**Bowling Pins:** The party of the second part agrees to furnish for use in this tournament USBC approved, select pins, subject to the approval of the tournament director. Said pins shall weigh not less than 3 lbs. 6 oz., or more than 3 lbs. 10 oz. per pin in sets.

**Score Keeping:** The party of the second part agrees to furnish automatic scorekeeping equipment, or the necessary manual scorekeeping sheets necessary for this tournament. Records shall be turned into the tournament director. If bidding with score keepers' party of the second part agrees to supply one (1) score keeper for not more than six (6) lanes for automatic score keeping. If manual scorekeeping party of the second part agrees to supply one (1) score keeper for not more than one (1) set of lanes.

**Bowling fees:** The party of the first part agrees to pay the party of the second part the sum of \$\_\_\_\_\_, tax charge \_\_\_\_\_, Total charge \_\_\_\_\_, for each three (3) lines of scheduled bowling. This money shall be paid to the party of the second part as agreed upon by both parties. See last page for agreement. The above sums to include \_\_\_\_\_ minutes of practice bowling before each squad.

**Work & Check In Space:** The party of the second part agrees to furnish suitable space for the Tournament Secretary, Tournament Director, and the tournament staff. Said space to include tables, chairs, and such other equipment as may be required by Tournament Secretary and staff, without charge to the party of the first part.

**Personnel:** The party of the second part agrees to furnish usual employees of the establishment, such as desk help, maintenance men, janitors, and any others deemed necessary for the success of the tournament. The party of the second part agrees to instruct all house employees that they are not to assume any responsibility for the conduction of the tournament. All participants shall be referred to the tournament staff for any interpretations or decisions in connection with the tournament.

**Lane Availability:** All lanes numbered \_\_\_\_\_ to \_\_\_\_\_ inclusive shall be available for scheduling each tournament weekend. The party of the second part agrees to accept the schedule for any part or all of the above lanes. All lanes must be cleared and run at least twenty (20) minutes prior to the starting time of the first squad each day. The party of the second part agrees to keep at least one (1) set of dark lanes between tournament play and open play. On the day that a contestant is scheduled to bowl in the tournament, cannot practice on his assigned lanes. Desk personnel shall be instructed to enforce this rule.

**General Provisions:** The party of the second part agrees to instruct employees not serve food or beverages in the bowler's area. The party of the second part agrees to make sure all ordinances of City, County, and State, regarding safety, fire prevention, etc., shall be complied with and will not interfere with tournament operations.

**Contract:** The party of the second part agrees that a responsible representative shall be on hand one (1) hour prior to and during all scheduled squads of the tournament. There shall be but one (1) representative of the establishment present at all times whom the tournament director or staff may consult. A responsible representative who is empowered to conclude the terms of this contract shall be at the tournament site on the final day of the tournament. The party of the second part agrees that should the bowling center or any associated facility, be sold or leased to another party, the terms of this contract shall be included in the escrow or lease agreement. Any new owner or manager shall be thoroughly acquainted with this contract.

**Advertising:** Under this agreement, the party of the first shall have the power to place in publications of its choice, any advertising deemed necessary to properly promote the tournament. The foregoing, consisting three (3) pages, has been entered into and subscribed to this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_ 20\_\_\_\_ by and between the party of the first part and the party of the second part. Both parties agree that this contract is entered into in the spirit of good faith and with the spirit of bowling foremost in the operations of this tournament.

**Brackets:** The party of the first part will offer brackets. St. Joseph USBC Association will run the brackets.
